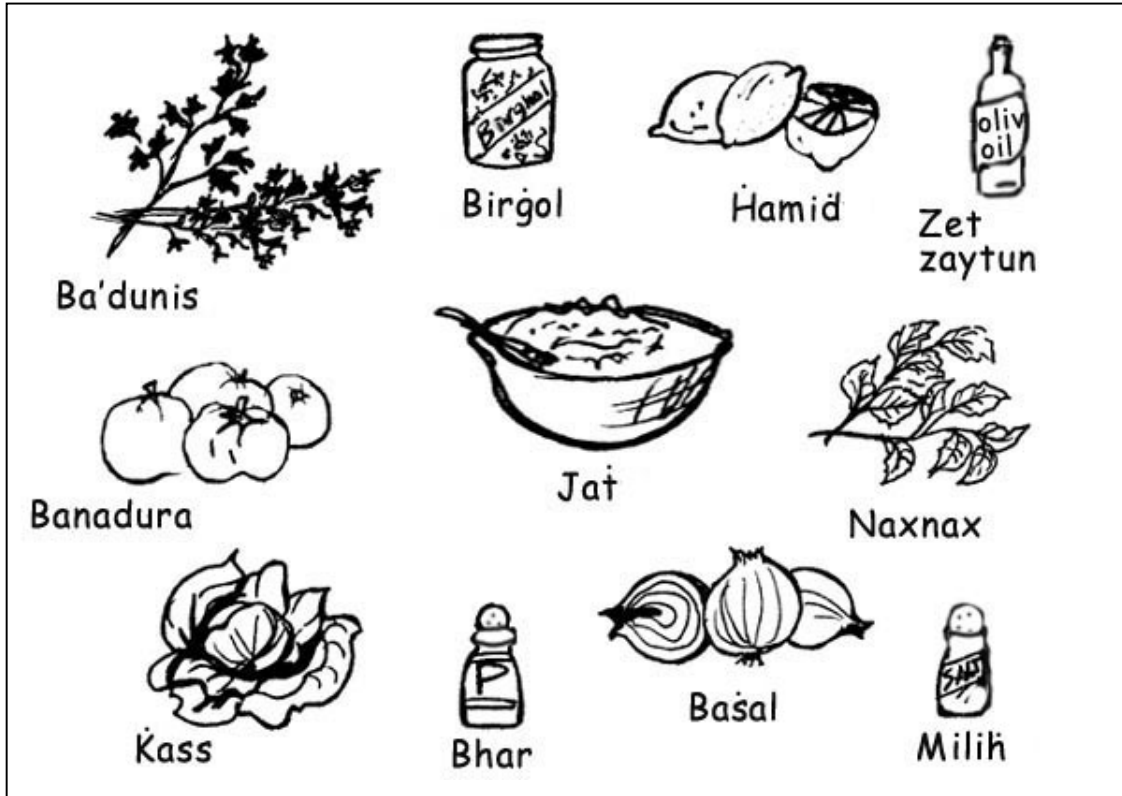
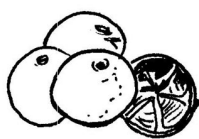

Recipe
Tabbule Ingredients

3 cups of finely chopped parsley
1/2 cup of finely chopped mint
Small onion
¼ cup ground wheat
½ cup lemon juice
4 table spoons olive oil
Salt and Pepper
Soak the birghol in cold water.
Mix everything together, taste and adjust seasoning. Serve with lettuce leaves.
